Abstracts, papers and submission

The topics can be addressed according to three main sets of approaches:

- Socio-political considerations (including policies, public information and debate)

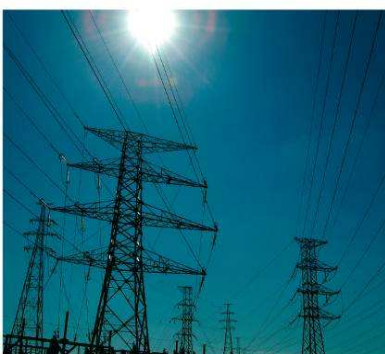

The abstracts must be detailed at a length of approximately 800 words and must be submitted online on the website. The final papers should be 4000-5000 words and are to be presented either orally or as a poster.
